# Decipherment of Estonian iron sword pommel

An iron sword from Estonia, offered for sale on eBay, is in spectacular shape; perhaps the iron contains chromium from the meteor that landed on the island of Saaremaa around 5500 BC. It could be 2000 years old, from the age when Estonians ruled the Baltic Sea. In addition to an Ogham inscription on the cross piece, the pommel contains a prayer in Old European.

The oblong pommel has four lines of two different lengths that allow separation of the letters. It is meant to be rotated and read four different ways:

## English

- 1 Favor your man,
- 2 Great Star Mother;
- 3 the blacksmith forged the blade
- 4 to bravely defeat men.

Great Star Mother was a planet three times the size of Earth in a circular orbit with a period of four years where the Asteroid Belt now lies. Sumerian cylinder seal VA-243 calls her Äiti meaning 'Mother'; Sumerian clay tablets call her Tiamat meaning 'Mother'; Egyptian hieroglyphics call her Mut meaning 'Mother'. In 9416 BC, a fiery planet Nibiru, ten times the size of Earth, with a narrow retrograde orbit of 20 years, fatally impaled Äiti with one of its moons. As she died, Äiti transferred her largest moon to Nibiru, who promptly delivered it to Earth in 9397 BC, called Moon. It was the greatest gift ever given to Earth, a moon to light the sky at night (Harris, 2018).

Old European is a Consonant-Vowel syllabary. The rules for reading and writing Old European never vary: drop final consonant of a syllable; ignore internal D, H, J, T and V; compress double letters into a single letter; compress diphthongs into the first vowel; obey vowel harmony.

Table 1 summarizes Old European syllabary prior to introduction of curved elements, one of two tools needed to translate inscriptions into Finnish and to diagnose compound letters built from several syllables. With this table and an Excel dictionary of Old European, anyone can translate ancient inscriptions.
